- WHEREAS, the cooperation, commitment and support of all the residents of the City of Idaho Falls is necessary to removing barriers to the enjoyment of living where one chooses within one's means.


THEREFORE, I, REBECCA CASPER, MAYOR of the City of Idaho Falls, do hereby proclaim the month of April 2016 as
