Tautphaus Park Zoo School Offers May Tots Education Classes

Don't miss this chance to bring your toddler to Zoo School!

Idaho Falls, Idaho, April 29, 2013 – What animals make up our barnyard buddies? Which ducks at the zoo can also be found in Idaho? Why are bears so cute? Kids' ages 2-5 can bring their favorite adult to the zoo and spend the morning learning about goats and donkeys, ducks, and bears during this year's May Tots Zoo Education classes. Classes are 45 minutes in length and will feature crafts, stories, and animals at the zoo.

This year the zoo is offering three different classes, one topic each week of May. Classes will be held on Tuesday and Friday mornings at 10:00 a.m. from May 7 – May 24, 2013. Classes are \$15.00 per class for an adult/child pair. **NEW** this year: if you sign up an individual child for all three class topics save 20% off the total price. Pre-registration for all zoo classes is required. Hurry! The registration deadline is **3 days prior to the class** and space in each class is limited.
