## **I.F. High School student arrested for Aggravated Assault**

Idaho Falls police arrested a 16-year-old Idaho Falls High School student Tuesday for aggravated assault after he attempted to stab another student during a verbal altercation outside the school.

According to a police report, the two students had gotten into a confrontation when one student pulled out a knife and began trying to stab the other student several times. The fight was broken up after friends intervened.

As school officials were investigating the incident, the student with the knife took off. He was later arrested by police in the 300 block of Seventh Street and taken to the 3B Detention Center.

The youth was also arrested for possession of a deadly weapon on school grounds.
