Boise Man Arrested for Road Rage Incident

Idaho Falls Police arrested a man for aggravated assault Thursday morning following an incident of road rage on South Holmes Avenue near 14th Street.

Sean McKenna, 53, of Boise reportedly threatened another driver with a pistol after the two were involved in a minor accident.

According to a police report, the incident happened around 9:30 a.m. after McKenna's car and another driver's truck collided as the double lanes merged into a single lane.

Both drivers stopped and exchanged words after pulling off to the side of the road to wait for police. The truck driver reported to police that McKenna pulled out a pistol from his car and pointed it at him.

McKenna fled from the scene but was later stopped by officers on U.S. Highway 20 near the Ucon exit. Officers seized the loaded Springfield Armory XD-45 pistol from McKenna.

McKenna was also booked into the Bonneville County Jail for leaving the scene of an accident.

IFPD Investigates School Burglary

The Idaho Falls Police Department is investigating an early morning burglary at Dora Erickson Elementary School.

According to a police, a school employee reported the burglary Friday after finding a broken window on the southside of the building and a damaged vending machine inside the school.

Information retrieved by police indicates that the school's internal alarm, which does not alert the police department, went off just after midnight and stopped just after 3 a.m.

The estimated damage is around \$1,500. It was unknown at the time of the report if anything had been taken.
