Police arrest Idaho Falls man for lewd conduct

Idaho Falls Police arrested Joseph David Rain (DOB 10/20/1972) of Idaho Falls Monday night for one count lewd conduct with a child under 16, a felony, and one count statutory rape, a felony.

According to detectives Rain has had an ongoing sexual relationship with a 14-year-old girl since January.

Rain is currently being held at the Bonneville County Jail. The case remains under investigation.

Idaho Falls mother arrested for misdemeanor injury to a child

Idaho Falls Police arrested Randi Renee Jackson (DOB 3/3/1978) Monday night for battery on a police officer, injury to a child and attempted possession of marijuana, all misdemeanors.

According to a police report, during an inspection of Jackson's home with Child Protective Services, Jackson became uncooperative and was placed under arrest. As the officer attempted to handcuff her, she began kicking and hitting him several times.

During the home inspection, officers and CPS said Jackson had placed her two children in danger as the house was "extremely messy". There were dried feces on the floor, rotten moldy food in the kitchen and in the refrigerator, dirty clothes strewn throughout the house and bottles of prescription medication left all around the house.

Officers also located drug paraphernalia at the home.

Both children were taken by CPS.

Two arrested for methamphetamine

Dean Anthony Spain (DOB 12/24/1986) and Michael A. Hope (DOB 10-7-1985) both of Idaho Falls were arrested Tuesday morning for possession of a controlled substance, a felony.

Idaho Falls Police made contact with Spain during a traffic stop on the 900 block of West Broadway just after midnight for driving a car that violated the city's dark window tint ordinance. During the traffic stop, the officer noticed that Spain was possibly under the influence of drugs.

As officers investigated, they found Spain and Hope to be in possession of methamphetamine. Officers also found two marijuana pipes in Hope's pockets.

Hope was additionally arrested for possession of drug paraphernalia, a misdemeanor.
