## **Idaho Falls Police investigate home burglaries**

Idaho Falls Police are investigating two home burglaries that occurred in the last two days. Police are now looking for unknown suspects who stole jewelry, cash and two safes.

According to police reports, officers were dispatched to a residence in the 4100 block of Stonebrook Lane around 9:30 p.m. Tuesday night after the owner came home and noticed a broken rear patio door.

Officers said suspects rifled through the master bedroom and bathroom strewing clothing and other items throughout the rooms before taking jewelry, cash and two small safes from the home.

No other rooms in the home were disturbed.

Police were also dispatched Wednesday afternoon for a burglary alarm at a residence in the 3000 block of Kevin Circle.

Upon arrival Officers found that the window of a back door to the house broken. The house was checked for suspects, but no one was found.

During their investigation, police and the owner noted that the home had been rifled through as kitchen cabinets; drawers and locked doors were found open. Papers and other items had also been scattered.

The owner reported that jeweler and cash had been stolen.

Both burglaries remain under investigation.
