## **Police Catch Thief**

Idaho Falls Police arrested Dustin Don Strange early Sunday morning for two counts of burglary and one count petty theft for stealing a car stereo and other items from a snow shack and car wash.

Strange, 28, of Gresham, Ore., was caught after a resident witnessed the thefts and immediately called police.

Police responded to the intersection of Alan and Ashment around 6 a.m. after a resident reported Strange breaking into his pick-up truck. Officers scouted the area and found Strange hiding behind a pick-up truck parked on Alan Street.

Strange was found in possession of the stolen stereo and items taken from the Spray Me Down car wash and adjoining snack shack.

### **I.F. Man Arrested for Aggravated Battery**

Idaho Falls Police arrested a 19-year-old man for aggravated battery after he injured another man during a fight in a parking lot near the intersection of Holmes Avenue and 17<sup>th</sup> Street.

Casey Scott Chaffin of Idaho Falls was arrested Friday as a result of a July 22 fight.

The victim reported to police that Chaffin punched him several times during an altercation. The altercation started after the victim and others were approached by Chaffin and his friends asking for their names. The victim refused and told Chaffin to “mind his own business”.

### **I.F. Man Arrested After Running from Police**

Idaho Falls Police arrested Michael Glen Jimenez Thursday night for possession of marijuana, possession of drug paraphernalia, obstructing and resisting an officer and destruction of evidence.

According to a report, police stopped Jimenez at Boulevard and 15<sup>th</sup> Street around 11:30 p.m. He was riding his bicycle, which was pulling his daughter in a cart, with no light.

During the stop, police said Jimenez acted suspicious. Officers searched him and found marijuana in his possession.

While being questioned by police, Jimenez fled, leaving his daughter behind, from police. While fleeing, Jimenez attempted to destroy a glass pipe.

Police caught Jimenez after a short foot pursuit. The daughter was placed in a family member’s custody.
