Officers Make Felony Drug Arrest

Idaho Falls Police arrested a 27-year-old man Thursday for felony possession of methamphetamine after he was found dealing drugs out a garage in the 100 block of May Street.

The man also was arrested for three Bonneville County warrants, possession of marijuana and drug paraphernalia.

Police responded to the 100 block of May around 8 p.m. after receiving information that the man was dealing drugs. When police arrived officers knocked on the door of the garage and the man refused to come out.

After speaking with him, police were able to eventually get the man to come to the door.

A K9 searched the building after the owner consented. Officers recovered 8.6 grams of methamphetamine, 3.8 grams of marijuana, scales, pipes and a torch.
