## **I.F. Woman Arrested for Stealing Medication**

Idaho Falls Police arrested a 26-year-old woman Tuesday for stealing medications from Eastern Idaho Regional Medical Center's Emergency Room.

Krystal Nichole Gilbert of Idaho Falls was booked into the Bonneville County Jail for petty theft, a misdemeanor, and felony possession of a controlled substance.

According to reports, police were dispatched to the 700 block of East 17<sup>th</sup> Street around 4:30 p.m. at the request of EMS.

While responding on a medical call, EMS responders received information that Gilbert had stolen Hydromorphone from EIRMC during a previous visit to the emergency room.
