## **I.F. Man and Woman Arrested for Delivery**

Idaho Falls Police arrested a 19-year-old man and 19-year-old woman Wednesday night for possession of marijuana with the intent to deliver, a felony.

Officers also referred a 15-year-old juvenile for possession of drug paraphernalia.

According to reports, the arrests stemmed from information received about the man and woman.

Officers located the suspects and initiated a stop on the vehicle they were driving. During the stop, officers found 1.4 ounces of marijuana in their possession and a few hundred dollars in cash.

## **Man Arrested for Eluding**

Idaho Falls Police arrested Clark Jesse Schwab Wednesday for eluding police in early May.

Schwab, 21, was arrested on a felony warrant at 12<sup>th</sup> Street and Hoopes Avenue.

According to a police report, an officer attempted to stop Schwab in a white Subaru Impreza station wagon on May 3 near the intersection of "H" and Idaho streets just before midnight for a traffic violation. Schwab accelerated in an effort to elude police after the officer turned on his overhead lights.

The officer followed the vehicle, which was being driven at high speeds, until he lost sight of it as it headed north on U.S. Highway 20.

Officers continued attempts to stop Schwab on the highway after it was spotted at exit 311 and on Yellowstone Highway, but the car continued to elude police as it reached speeds up to 30 miles over the posted speed limit. Police stopped pursuit as the vehicle continued to drive at high speeds.

Police spoke with the owner of the vehicle who told officers he had leant the car to Schwab and another person he'd met through a mutual friend. Neither person would return any telephone calls or return the car.

The car was later recovered on G Street on May 4. Evidence at the scene lead officers to the arrest of Scwab.
