Calling All Residents – Have You Lost a Bicycle?

Have you lost a bicycle? If so, check with the Idaho Falls Police Department.

The Idaho Falls Police Department is looking to reunite owners with the numerous lost or recovered bicycles that have been turned into the police station.

Property Assistant Mickey Callow said the department currently has several bicycles in the lost and found that have been turned into police. Many of the bicycles will be auctioned on propertyroom.com if no one claims it.

“I think a lot of people are losing bikes, but they aren’t wanting to find them,” Callow said.

Bicycles are held at the police station for 30 days before they are auctioned.

Callow encourages people to call and claim their bicycles as she’d like to return them to their rightful owner. If you can, please provide a serial number or any identifiable mark to assist us in finding your bicycle.

The IFPD also reminds residents to register their bicycles with the department. If your bike is lost or stolen—and it is registered—it makes is so much easier for us to investigate and get it back to its rightful owner.
