City of Idaho Falls Taking Applications for Civil Service Testing

Have you ever dreamt of becoming a police officer in in the hopes of making a difference in your community? Or perhaps you've longed for a career in criminal justice?

If you have, you'll be pleased to know that the City of Idaho Falls is now accepting candidates to participate in the Civil Service testing for the position of probationary police officer. Applications must be submitted by June 10 to participate in the Civil Service Test on June 17.

The Department is looking for good, quality people to fill at least two positions, possibly more, from the pool of candidates that participate in the testing.

The top 30 candidates that meet the minimum scoring requirements on the 100-question Civil Service test will be invited to participate in an oral interview and physical fitness test on June 18.
