### **Women Arrested for Forgery and Fraud**

Idaho Falls Police arrested two women in separate incidents Monday for felony fraud and forgery as a result of illegally obtaining prescription medications.

Erin M. Knoth, 29, of Idaho Falls was arrested for felony forgery and misdemeanor unlawful possession of prescription drugs. Amanda Munns, 29, of Idaho Falls was arrested for felony prescription fraud.

According to the police, officers responded to Walgreens on West Broadway around 1:30 p.m. after the pharmacy reported that Knoth attempted to purchase medication with a forged doctor's prescription.

Officers arrested Knoth at her residence.

Monday morning, officers also arrested Munns following an investigation into her illegally obtaining someone's prescription medication from Smith's Pharmacy on May 10.

Both Munns and Knoth were booked into the Bonneville County Jail.
