Open House for Mid-Century Modern: The open house/self-guided tour consists of two local homes of Mid-Century Modern architecture; 460 9th Street, and 4012 S. 5th West. The event is from 10:00 am to Noon. Members should be available from 9:30 am to 12:30 pm on Saturday, July 28. Commission members assisting with the event will divide between the two properties to answer questions and ensure each home is carefully regarded. The representing realtors will be present to assist with questions related to the purchase of the homes..

There was some discussion about the impact traffic may have on the neighborhoods because of the event and the idea of a shuttle was considered. The final consensus was there is adequate parking in close proximity to each home. Refreshments are not necessary.

Mitro will meet with Reggie Fuller, chief building official, to discuss the architectural features of each home to be highlighted. Whipple will incorporate the information in handouts for each home and make them available to the public for self-guided tours. Petty has event flyers ready for distribution, sent a display ad to the Post Register and had information posted to the city's webpage.
