## Minutes

**Attending:** Roxane Mitro, Hereschell Mynarcik, Kim Smith, Graham Whipple, and Judy Mortimer. Renee Magee and Brad Cramer, staff.

### **Call to Order at 12:00 p.m.**

**Minutes:** Mitro moved to accept the minutes of June 25, July 2, and August 1 with the following corrections: on the July 2 minutes, fypon is the correct spelling and the discussion of paint may be best phrased as a “distinction line,” and, as to August 1, she was not in attendance. Whipple said the applicant’s name is Jack, not Jacks. Smith seconded the motion, and it passed unanimously.

**Walking Tour of Tautphaus Drive:** Whipple confirmed Reggie Fuller was available to lead a tour. The tour will be at 10:00 a.m. The general meeting area is at the south at Calkins Avenue in Tautphaus Park. There will be two groups and one will begin on Curtis Avenue. Mynarcik suggested enlarging the 1950’s subdivision to be available for an introductory discussion. A letter was sent to the home owners on Curtis Avenue and Tautphaus Drive. A copy of the flyer and advertisement was distributed to the Commission members. Whipple will post the flyer on the Facebook page. The Commission agreed to meet about 9:40 or 9:45 a.m. at the pedestrian access from Calkins to the park.

**Work Program and Application to SHPO:** Magee distributed the proposed work program. It proposed completing the reconnaissance survey in Keefer Addition, Hughes Imperial Estates, and the first few divisions of Home Ranch. These subdivisions were spurred with the building of Catholic hospital on South Boulevard. Magee will distribute the letter to SHPO and Julie’s comments to the Commission members. A second walking tour is in the work program for the Ridge Avenue area. A walking tour may provide publicity for the Hitt House. Travel is included in next year’s work program. There may be opportunities in Idaho such as the Heritage Conference in Boise at the end of September this year. Mortimer said there will be a tour of the archives or warehouse of the Idaho Historic Society at the Heritage Conference. There is money under administration for reprinting the brochures and National Register plaques. Magee suggested the First Presbyterian Church be given a plaque for the Hitt House. The Commission discussed the history of the Linger House and ideas to encourage the Church to retain the Hitt House. Mitro moved to approved the work program for Fiscal Year 2013-14. Mortimer seconded the motion, and it passed unanimously.

**Miscellaneous:** Magee introduced Brad Cramer, Assistant Planning Director, to the Commission. She will be retiring on Halloween. Magee outlined the tasks to be done prior to the walking tour.

**Adjourn:** The meeting adjourned at 12:59 p.m.
