Duty of Property Owners:

City Ordinance Title 8 Chapter 10-1

Every person who owns real property within the City shall remove any snow, ice and other obstruction or dangerous condition upon any sidewalk,...abutting his or her property.

General Parking Restrictions:

November 14 to March 15

Night-Time Snow Removal:
8:00 PM to 8:00 AM - No Parking

Downtown:
12:00 AM to 8:00 AM
No Parking on North/South Streets:
Even Calendar Days
No Parking on East/West Streets:
Odd Calendar Days

Snow Event:

City Ordinance Title 9 Chapter 5

Zone A:
8:00 AM to 5:00 PM
No Parking on North/South Streets:
Even Calendar Days
No Parking on East/West Streets:
Odd Calendar Days

Zone B:
No Parking on Any Street, Any Day

Zone A and B parking restrictions go into effect ONLY during a Snow Event, as defined when more than two inches (2") of snow accumulates on the roadway.

During a Snow Event it will be the responsibility of vehicle owners to find parking other than on a restricted street or move the vehicle until the street is plowed. Illegally parked vehicles may be removed without notice to the owner.
