AN ORDINANCE CALLING AN ELECTION FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF SAID CITY THE PROPOSITION OF THE ISSUANCE OF \$8400,000 GENERAL OBLIGATION AIRPORT BONDS OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, AND PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF SUCH BONDS IN THE EVENT THEY ARE VOTED AT SUCH ELECTION.
