

OCTOBER 30, 1963

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Pursuant to a call by the Mayor, the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls met in Special Session in the Mayor's Chamber of the City Building on the 30<sup>th</sup> day of October, 1963 at 7:30 o'clock P. M. for the purpose of considering the awarding of a contract for the repair of the Eagle Rock Dam, as well as any other business which might properly be presented. There were present at said meeting Mayor W. J. O'Bryant; Councilmen Leahy, Page, Creek and Foote. Also present Roy C. Barnes, City Clerk; William Holden and Fred Hahn, from the City Attorney's Offices of Holden, Holden, and Kidwell.

Gentlemen:

On this date we opened informal bids for the repair of the damaged section of the Eagle Rock Dam. Bids were received as follows:

Wadsworth Construction Co.	\$10,895.00
Aiman Construction Co.	11,725.00
Goodwin Builders	11,887.00
Phillips Construction Co.	12,650.00
Hunter Saucerman Construction Co.	18,710.00

In reviewing the bidders, we find that Wadsworth Construction Co. does not have a Public Works Contractors License at this time. We have confirmed this with Mr. Molitor in Boise by Telephone this date.

We have reviewed Aiman Construction Company's bid and find their prices commensurate with the job to be done under existing conditions and consideration of the oncoming cold weather. In the discussion with Mr. Molitor, we reviewed the question of the type of Public Works Contractors License now being held by Aiman's Company and he indicates no objection on this particular job for this company but did recommend the contractor change his type of license if he proposes to continue in this type of construction.

We would recommend that the Mayor and City Council award the construction of this project to Aiman Construction Co. according to the unit prices in his proposal and at the estimated sum of \$11,725.00.

Since the memo was prepared, the Mayor noted that the State Licensing Bureau had verified, by telegram, the fact that the license of the low bidder was in good standing. It was moved by Councilman Leahy, seconded by Page, that Wadsworth Construction, as low bidder, be awarded the contract for repair of the Eagle Rock Dam. Roll call as follows: Ayes, 4; No, None; carried.

A license application for PHOTOGRAPHER in the name of Aunt Mary's Studio was reviewed. It was noted that the license had previously been presented to the Council and had been referred to the Police Chief for investigation. It was moved by Councilman Foote, seconded by Creek, that the license be denied based upon the findings of said Police investigation. Roll call as follows: Ayes, 4; No, None; carried.

The Councils' attention was drawn to the fact that there had been certain inquiries relative to the possible sale of sand from the sand dune property. It was moved by Leahy, seconded by Foote, that the City offer said sand for sale for 10¢ per yard, subject to advice of Counsel as to the legality of this procedure in the absence of advertised requests for bids. Roll call as follows: Ayes, 4; No, None; carried. It was understood and agreed that the City Engineer be responsible for the specific location from whence the sand be taken as well as quantity.

It was noted that joint bids had been opened October 24<sup>th</sup>, 1963, in the interests of the School District and the City, for certain petroleum products but that each agency had been given the privilege of acceptance without the approval of the other. Low bids were revealed as follows:

It was moved by Councilman Creek, seconded by Leahy, that these low bids be accepted by the City for the petroleum products as described. Roll call as follows: Ayes, 4; No, None; carried.

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The Mayor asked the Council to determine and schedule a public hearing for consideration of the new Zoning Ordinance. It was moved by Councilman Page, seconded by Creek, that said hearing be set for November 18<sup>th</sup>, 1963 at 8:00 P.M. in the Civic Auditorium and that the City Clerk be authorized to publish notice accordingly. Roll call as follows: Ayes, 4; No, None; carried.

There being no further business, it was moved by Councilman Leahy, seconded by Page, that the Meeting adjourn. Carried.
