

OCTOBER 1, 1963

Pursuant to a call by the Mayor, the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls met in Special Session in the Council Chambers of the City Building on the 1st day of October, 1963, at 2:00 P.M., for the purpose of considering various matters requiring Council consideration. There were present at said Meeting: Mayor W. J. O'Bryant; Councilmen Creek, Foote, Leahy and Page. Also present: Roy C. Barnes, City Clerk; Vern Kidwell, City Attorney; Don Ellsworth, City Engineer.

Previous Council consideration had been given toward the possibility of a special question for the vote of the people at the November general municipal election to determine their wishes relative to the issuance of a general obligation fire improvement bond issue. It was moved by Councilman Leahy, seconded by Page, that this be deferred to a later date beyond the said November election. Roll call as follows: Ayes, 4; No, None; carried.

The subject of increasing the number of Councilmen on the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls from four to six members was discussed. It was moved by Councilman Creek, seconded by Leahy, that this special question be placed on the ballot at the November election. Roll call as follows: Ayes, 4; No, None; carried.

In view of the foregoing action, this ordinance was presented:

ORDINANCE NO. 1067

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR SUBMISSION TO THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, IDAHO, THE QUESTION OF WHETHER THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, IDAHO SHALL CONSIST OF FOUR OR SIX MEMBERS; PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION AND NOTICE; PROVIDING FOR PREPARATION OF BALLOTS; PROVIDING WHEN THE ORDINANCE SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

Gentlemen:

The attached letter is a time extension request from the contractor of the interior painting of the elevated water tank. A review of the conditions supporting this request indicates that some additional contract time is warranted.

It is recommended that the following time extension be granted to the contractor:

1. Delay attributable to change in primer paint (Sept. 17th and 18th) 2 days.
2. Delay attributable to weather (Sept. 19th and 1/2 day each on Sept. 21st and 23rd) 3 days.
3. Time for seam welding called for in addition to base contract - 1 1/2 days.
4. Time for the extra work item of installing inlet pipe collar rods - 1 day.

Total additional time 7 1/2 days.
