Pursuant to a call by the Mayor, the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls met in Special Session in the Mayor's Chambers of the City Building in the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, on May 28, 1963, at 3:00 P.M. for the purpose of considering a farm lease in favor of Wylie Snarr, covering certain farm lands in the vicinity of the airport.
