

APRIL 3, 1963

Pursuant to a call by the Mayor, the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls met in Special Session in the Mayor's Chambers in the City Hall of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, on April 3, 1963, at 8:00 P.M. for the purpose of considering a joint agreement between the State of Idaho, the Union Pacific Railroad and the City of Idaho Falls, relative to the widening of Yellowstone Avenue. There were present at said meeting: Mayor W. J. O'Bryant, Councilmen Page, Leahy, Creek, Foote. Also present Roy C. Barnes, City Clerk.

A contract was presented between the Union Pacific Railroad, the State of Idaho and the City of Idaho Falls covering the Yellowstone Highway widening project from the G Street underpass to the South City Limits at 25th Street and all necessary relocation of railroad facilities pertaining thereto. In this connection, this resolution was presented:

RESOLUTION (Resolution No. 1963-04)

WHEREAS, there has been proposed an agreement between Oregon Short Line Railroad Company, the State of Idaho and the City of Idaho Falls, with respect to the reconstruction of U. S. Highway 91-191 through Idaho Falls, Idaho; and

WHEREAS, the terms and provisions of the said agreement, and the benefits and obligations thereof to the City of Idaho Falls, have been reviewed in detail; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed in the best interest of the City of Idaho Falls to enter into said agreement,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Mayor and City Clerk be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to make, execute and deliver the said agreement.
