There were present at said Meeting, Mayor W. J. O'Bryant; Councilman Page, Creek, Foote, Leahy. Also present: Roy C. Barnes, City Clerk; Luther Jenkins, City Controller.

ORDINANCE NO. 1052

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN LANDS TO THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, DESCRIBING SAID LANDS AND DECLARING SAME A PART OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, IDAHO

It was moved by Councilman Leahy, seconded by Creek, that the provisions of Section 50-2004 of the Idaho Code requiring all ordinances to be fully and distinctly read on three several days be dispensed with. The question being, "SHALL THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 50-2004 OF THE IDAHO CODE REQUIRING ALL ORDINANCES TO BE READ ON THREE SEVERAL DAYS BE DISPENSED WITH?" Roll call as follows: Ayes, 4; No, None; carried. The majority of all the members of the Council present having voted in the affirmative, the Mayor declared the rule dispensed with and ordered the Ordinance placed before the Council for final consideration the question being, "SHALL THE ORDINANCE PASS?" Roll call as follows: Ayes, 4; No, None; carried.

Controller Jenkins presented certain rules and regulations for forms control and printing services. It was moved by Councilman Leahy, seconded by Foote, that these be accepted and approved with minor revisions as proposed by Councilman Leahy, effective March 12th, 1963, and that they be incorporated and made a part of the City of Idaho Falls operating procedures manual. Roll call as follows: Ayes, 4; No, None; carried.

There being no further business, it was moved by Councilman Leahy, seconded by Page, that the Meeting adjourn. Carried.
