

NOVEMBER 6, 1962

Pursuant to a call by the Mayor, the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls met in Special Session in the Mayor's Chambers on Tuesday, November 6, 1962, at 3:30 P.M. for the purpose of awarding a bid for a fire truck, as well as any other business which might properly be presented. There were present at said Meeting: Mayor W. J. O'Bryant; Councilmen Foote, Page, Leahy, Creek. Also present: Roy C. Barnes, City Clerk; Parley Gillen, Fire Chief.

It was noted that bids had been opened October 1st, 1962, on a snorkel type fire truck which revealed the following:

These had, in the interim period, been the subject of considerable study by the Councilmen. It was moved by Councilman Creek, seconded by Page, that the Crown Coach bid for the Custom Pitman in the amount of \$57,080.16 be accepted. Roll call as follows: Ayes, 4; No, None; carried.

ORDINANCE NO. 1040

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING COSTS AND EXPENSES OF LOCAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 28 IMPROVEMENTS; CONFIRMING THE CREATION AND ESTABLISHMENT OF SAID LOCAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 28 OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, IDAHO, FOR STREET AND ALLEY IMPROVEMENTS WITHIN SAID DISTRICT; APPROVING THE ASSESSMENT ROLL FOR SAID DISTRICT; PROVIDING FOR THE PAYMENT IN INSTALLMENTS OF THE COST AND EXPENSES OF THE IMPROVEMENTS TO BE MADE IN SAID DISTRICT; PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUE OF IMPROVEMENT BONDS OF THE DISTRICT; ASSESSING THE COST OF THE

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IMPROVEMENTS AGAINST THE LOTS, BLOCKS, AND PARCELS OF LAND IN SAID DISTRICT CONTIGUOUS OR ADJACENT TO, FRONTING OR ABUTTING ON THE STREETS AND ALLEYS TO BE IMPROVED, OR BENEFITED BY SAID IMPROVEMENTS, IN PROPORTION TO THE BENEFITS DERIVED TO SUCH PROPERTY BY SAID IMPROVEMENTS; PRESCRIBING THE MANNER FOR THE COLLECTION AND PAYMENT OF SAID ASSESSMENTS; PROVIDING FOR THE CREATION OF A LOCAL IMPROVEMENT GUARANTEE FUND FOR THE PAYMENT OF SAID LOCAL IMPROVEMENT BONDS; AND PROVIDING WHEN THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE IN EFFECT.

It was moved by Councilman Foote, seconded by Page, that the provisions of Section 50-2004 of the Idaho Code requiring all ordinances to be fully and distinctly read on three several days be dispensed with. The question being, "SHALL THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 50-2004 OF THE IDAHO CODE REQUIRING ALL ORDINANCES TO BE READ ON THREE SEVERAL DAYS BE DISPENSED WITH?" Roll call as follows: Ayes, 4; No, None; carried.

Two tax redemption deeds were presented both in the name of William E. Galbraith. It was moved by Councilman Foote, seconded by Page, that the Mayor and City Clerk be authorized to sign. Roll call as follows: Ayes, 4; No, None; carried.

There being no further business, it was moved by Councilman Leahy, seconded by Page, that the Meeting adjourn. Carried.
