

OCTOBER 30, 1962

Pursuant to a call by the Mayor the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls met in Special Session in the Mayor's Chambers on Tuesday, October 30, 1962 at 2:00 P.M. for the purpose of considering the awarding of bids on the installation of a service pit at the City Garage, as well as any other business which might properly be presented. There were present at said Meeting: Mayor W. J. O'Bryant; Councilmen Foote, Page, Leahy, Creek. Also present: Roy C. Barnes, City Clerk; George Barnard, City Attorney; Don Lloyd, Public Works Director; Luther Jenkins, Controller.

The Public Works Director made reference to bids, opened earlier, covering the installation of a service pit and overhead door at the City Garage, as follows:

C.B.S Construction	\$5,800.00
Wadsworth Construction	6,289.00
Goodwin Builders	4,605.00
Aiman Construction	5,686.00

In this connection the following memo was read:

Gentlemen:

Please find attached hereto a tabulation of the bids received for the installation of a service pit at the City Garage.

We have reviewed the low bid and find that it is a reasonable cost for the labor and materials, and is within our prepared estimate. We would recommend to the Mayor and Council that the contract be awarded to Goodwin Builders for the construction of this service pit in the amount of \$4,605.00.

In addition to this work under contract, the Building Maintenance crew must remove the block wall opening for the installation of the overhead door. Further, it will be necessary to remove a sidewalk and gutter section and replace with a driveway approach.

Two tax redemption deeds were presented, in the names of Kenneth A. Anderson and Gladys S. Lords. It was moved by Councilman Foote, seconded by Page, that the Mayor and City Clerk be authorized to sign. Roll call as follows: Ayes, 4; No, None; carried.

The Public Works Director presented, by memorandum, a plan of snow removal for the coming winter, outlining the three major functions to be accomplished; namely, de-icing, plowing, and snow removal. This was presented by chart, showing the organization and need for equipment and man power. It was explained that, for the efficient and complete execution of the project one large plow and two small plow blades were needed, costing approximately \$2,500.00. It was moved by Councilman Leahy, seconded by Creek, that the snow removal program, as outlined, including the capital outlay, be approved. Roll call as follows: Ayes, 4; No, None; carried.

There being no further business, it was moved by Councilman Leahy, seconded by Page, that the Meeting adjourn. Carried.
