

OCTOBER 2, 1962

Pursuant to a call by the Mayor the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls met in Special Session in the Mayor's Chambers on Tuesday, October 2, 1962 at 2:30 P.M. for the purpose of considering a cooperative agreement with the State of Idaho, Department of Highways, as well as any other business which might properly be presented. There were present at said Meeting: Mayor W. J. O'Bryant; Councilmen Creek, Foote, Page. Absent: Councilman Leahy. Also present: Roy C. Barnes, City Clerk; George Barnard, City Attorney; Luther Jenkins, Controller.

The following resolution was presented:

RESOLUTION (Resolution No. 1962-09)

WHEREAS, the Department of Highways of the State of Idaho has submitted a Preliminary Cooperative Agreement stating obligations of the State and the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, for reconstructing U.S. Highways 20-26-91-191 within the corporate limits of the City of Idaho Falls, Bonneville County, Idaho, as described in the Preliminary Cooperative Agreement, which improvement will include certain changes in the facilities of the Union Pacific Railroad Company and grading, draining and surfacing on approximately 1.56 miles of highway to be constructed under Federal Aid Projects F-6033(5) and F-6471(11); and

WHEREAS, it is in the public interest that the State and the City cooperate in planning and financing the above described improvements; and

WHEREAS, the said improvements will benefit the City by eliminating traffic congestion caused by railroad operations and by providing for additional off-street parking adjacent to the central business district; and

WHEREAS, it is advisable for the City and State to enter into a preliminary agreement establishing the respective responsibilities of the City and the State;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

1. That the Preliminary Cooperative Agreement for Federal Aid Projects F-6033(5) and F-6471(11) is hereby accepted and approved.
2. That the Mayor and the City Clerk are hereby authorized to execute the Preliminary Cooperative Agreement on behalf of the City of Idaho Falls.
3. That duly certified copies of this resolution shall be furnished the Department of Highways.

It was moved by Councilman Page, seconded by Foote, that this resolution be accepted and approved. Roll call as follows: Ayes, 3; No, None; carried. It was noted that the foregoing resolution provides for Mayor and City Clerk authorization to sign the agreement in question.

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Reference is made to a zoning hearing held August 22nd, 1962, at which time Orlin Park, Division #6 was zoned, except for Lots 26, 27, and 28, Block 22, Orlin Park Division #6 be zoned R-3. Roll call as follows: Ayes, 3; No, None; carried.

The Building Official, through the City Clerk, was instructed to incorporate this zoning on the official zoning map located in his office.

In this Book of Minutes, dated August 8th, 1962, it will be noted that the City Council approved an option agreement with the First Christian Church for the purchase, as, if and when exercised, of certain real property owned by that organization, described as Lots 7, 8, and 9, Block 31, Town of Eagle Rock.

A supplemental agreement to that option agreement was presented, outlining the terms and conditions whereby the Church would occupy the premises on a rental basis of \$50.00 a month but not beyond July 1st, 1964, even in the event the option is exercised. It was moved by Councilman Creek, seconded by Page, that the Mayor and City Clerk be authorized to sign. Roll call as follows: Ayes, 3; No, None; carried.

There being no further business, it was moved by Councilman Page, seconded by Foote, that the Meeting adjourn. Carried.
