Pursuant to a call by the Mayor the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls met in Special Session, Monday, April 16, 1962, in the Mayor's Chambers at 3:00 P.M. for the purpose of considering an ordinance regulating the conducting of commercial operations from or upon the Idaho Falls Municipal Airport. There were present at said Meeting: Mayor W. J. O'Bryant; Councilmen Page, Leahy, Creek. Absent, Councilman Foote. Also present: Roy C. Barnes, City Clerk; George Barnard, City Attorney.

ORDINANCE NO. 1024

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE CONDUCTING OF COMMERCIAL OPERATIONS FROM OR UPON THE IDAHO FALLS MUNICIPAL AIRPORT, MAKING IT UNLAWFUL TO CONDUCT THE SAME WITHOUT HAVING A LEASE OR CONTRACT COVERING SUCH OPERATIONS WITH THE CITY; REGULATING THE OPERATION OF AIRCRAFT FROM SAID AIRPORT FOR COMMERCIAL PURPOSES AND MAKING IT UNLAWFUL SO TO DO WITHOUT OBTAINING A PERMIT FROM THE CITY; REQUIRING A MINIMUM FEE TO BE PAID FOR SUCH PERMIT; EXEMPTING CERTAIN PERSONS OPERATING UNDER LEASE OR CONTRACT FROM CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF THE ORDINANCE; PROVIDING FOR THE ADOPTION OF RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE AIRPORT; AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION OF THE ORDINANCE.

The foregoing Ordinance was presented in title. It was moved by Councilman Creek, seconded by Leahy, that the provisions of Section 50-2004 of the Idaho Code requiring all ordinances to be fully and distinctly read on three several days be dispensed with. The question being "SHALL THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 50-2004 OF THE IDAHO CODE REQUIRING ALL ORDINANCES TO BE READ ON THREE SEVERAL DAYS BE DISPENSED WITH?" Roll call as follows: Ayes, 3; No, None; carried. The majority of all the members of the Council present having voted in the affirmative, the Mayor declared the rule dispensed with and ordered the Ordinance placed before the Council for final consideration, the question being, "SHALL THE ORDINANCE PASS?" Roll call as follows: Ayes, 3; No, None; carried.

There being no further business, it was moved by Councilman Leahy, seconded by Page, that the Council adjourn. Carried.
