

DECEMBER 29, 1961

Pursuant to a call by the Mayor, the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls met in Special Session in the Mayor's Chambers on Friday, December 29, 1961, at 10:00 A.M. for the purpose of approving as many City licenses as possible, prior to the end of the year. There were present at said Meeting: Mayor W. J. O'Bryant; Councilmen Creek, Foote, Page. Absent: Councilman Leahy. Also present: Roy C. Barnes, City Clerk.

License applications for Grocery Store, Restaurant, Soda Fountain, all previously approved by the City Sanitarian, were presented as follows: GROCERY STORE, Midget Market, Aiman's Super Market, and Glenn's Cold Storage; RESTAURANT, Koffee Kup Kafe and Flamingo Service, Inc.; SODA FOUNTAIN, Leslie Drug. It was moved by Councilman Foote, seconded by Creek, that these licenses be approved. Roll call as follows: Ayes, 3; No, None; carried.

License applications for Gas Contractor and Journeyman Gas Fitter, previously approved by the Gas Inspector were then presented for the following: GAS CONTRACTOR, Nugent Metal Works and Acme Mechanical; JOURNEYMAN GAS FITTER, Wesley D. Ennis, Verne E. Copes, Dave Harman, and Jack Hall. It was moved by Councilman Page, seconded by Foote, that the licenses be approved. Roll call as follows: Ayes, 3; No, None; carried.

License application for Journey Plumber, previously approved by the Building Official, for Verne E. Copes was next presented. It was moved by Councilman Creek, seconded by Page, that the license be approved. Roll call as follows: Ayes, 3; No, None; carried.

License applications were then presented for Rooming House, Canned & Bottled Beer Not To Be Consumed on the Premises and Canned & Bottled Beer To Be Consumed on the Premises, all previously approved by the Police Chief, for the following: ROOMING HOUSE (HOTEL) Marion Hotel; CANNED & BOTTLED BEER NOT TO BE CONSUMED ON THE PREMISES, Bybee's Holiday Market, Glenn's Cold Storage, Melgaard Grocery, Fairway Service, Aiman's Super Market, and Midget Market; CANNED & BOTTLED BEER TO BE CONSUMED ON THE PREMISES, Flamingo Service Inc., New Grand Hotel, and Jack's Club, and Ted LeBaron's Airport Lounge and Café.

Next to be presented was license application for Retail Liquor, Fred & Kelly's Broiler. It was moved by Councilman Creek, seconded by Foote, that this license be approved. Roll call as follows: Ayes, 3; No, None; carried.
