

DECEMBER 26, 1961

Pursuant to a call by the Mayor, the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls met in Special Session in the Mayor's Chambers on Tuesday, December 26, 1961 at 2:00 P.M. for the purpose of hearing testimony from the architect and the contractor with reference to the delay beyond the date which indicated on the construction contract which was experienced in the completion of the airport control tower, as well as any other business which might properly be presented. There were present at said Meeting: Mayor W. J. O'Bryant; Councilmen Creek, Foote, Leahy. Absent: Councilman Page. Also present: Roy C. Barnes, City Clerk; George Barnard, City Attorney.

Messrs. Lloyd Stalker, Golden Wadsworth, Don Hankins and Pete Hill appeared before the Council to answer questions or to offer testimony relative to the time delay and extensions beyond August 1st, 1961, date of completion on the airport control tower as indicated on the Wadsworth contract. Sufficient evidence was supplied to satisfy the Council that the delay was justified. It was moved by Councilman Foote, seconded by Leahy, that the City allow a 59 day extension of time to the contractor without liquidating damages and that the certificate of final inspection dated September 29th, 1961, be accepted. Roll call as follows: Ayes, 3; No, None; carried.

The Council had previously agreed to sell at auction certain lands located in Block 20, Winn's Addition. It was moved by Councilman Creek, seconded by Leahy, that the City Attorney be authorized to prepare a notice of intention to sell real estate accordingly. Roll call as follows: Ayes, 3; No, None; carried.

With reference to the aforementioned anticipated sale of real estate at auction it was moved by Councilman Creek, seconded by Foote, that the following be named as appraisers: Donald F. Lloyd, Sterling Mason, and Grover Bennett. Roll call as follows: Ayes, 3; No, None; carried.

There being no further business, it was moved by Councilman Leahy, seconded by Foote, that the Council adjourn. Carried.
