

NOVEMBER 21, 1961

Pursuant to a call by the Mayor, the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls met in Special Session in the Airport Administration Building on Tuesday, November 21, 1961, at 1:00 P.M. for the purpose of approving an FAA contract and awarding certain bids. There were present at said Meeting: Mayor W. J. O'Bryant; Councilmen Creek, Foote, Leahy. Absent: Councilman Page. Also present: Roy C. Barnes, City Clerk.

A contract from the FAA was presented covering ground rental for the remote control antenna. It was noted that the ground in question has been occupied several months and the contract when originally presented was inadvertently misplaced. It was moved by Councilman Creek, seconded by Foote, that the Mayor and City Clerk be authorized to sign. Roll call as follows: Ayes, 3; No, None; carried.

Bids on six blade snow plow units, previously opened, were reviewed. It was noted that Willy's Sales, Inc., Idaho Falls was apparent low bidder in the amount of \$3,516.00 and that other bidders were Arnold Machinery Company, Idaho Falls; Atlas Equipment Company, Pocatello; Flaherty Sales, Inc., Pocatello; Intermountain Equipment Company, Pocatello; Southern Idaho Equipment, Idaho Falls; Western Equipment Company, Pocatello. It was moved by Councilman Leahy, seconded by Creek, that the low bid of Willy's Sales be accepted. Roll call as follows: Ayes, 3; No, None; carried.

Next to be considered were bids on a material spreader, previously opened. Apparent low bidder, other than one which failed to meet specifications, was Engineering Sales & Service, Boise, Idaho, in the amount of \$995.00, other bidders being Atlas Equipment Company, Pocatello; Southern Idaho Equipment Company, Idaho Falls; and Western Road Machinery, Idaho Falls. It was moved by Councilman Creek, seconded by Foote, that the bid of Engineering Sales & Service be accepted. Roll call as follows: Ayes, 3; No, None; carried.

Last to be considered were bids on a truck chassis, previously opened. It was revealed that Smith Chevrolet Company, Idaho Falls, Idaho, was apparent low bidder in the amount of \$4,446.88. Other bidders being Snake River Equipment, Idaho Falls; and Stoddard Ford, Idaho Falls. It was moved by Councilman Foote, seconded by Leahy, that the bid of Smith Chevrolet Company be accepted. Roll call as follows: Ayes, 3; No, None; carried.

There being no further business, it was moved by Councilman Leahy, seconded by Creek, that the Council adjourn. Carried.
