

JULY 28, 1961

Pursuant to a call by the Mayor the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls met in Special Session in the Mayor's Chambers on July 28th, 1961, at 3:30 o'clock P.M., for the purpose of considering the approval of an electric service agreement with Utah Power & Light to provide electric service for a pump at the new sanitary land fill site, located approximately seven miles west of the City of Idaho Falls. There were present at said Meeting: Mayor W. J. O'Bryant; Councilmen Page, Leahy, Creek, Foote. Also present: Roy C. Barnes, City Clerk; George Barnard, City Attorney.

The following resolution was presented:

RESOLUTION (Resolution No. 1961-06)

WHEREAS, there has been submitted to the City of Idaho Falls at a duly convened meeting a proposed contract with the Utah Power Light Company by the terms of which said Company agrees to furnish electric energy for irrigation pumping purposes upon terms and conditions and therein fully set forth, which said contract is believed to be a fair one and one which it is advisable for the Municipality to enter into;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mayor of Idaho Falls be, and he is hereby authorized in his official capacity to execute said contract in duplicate and the City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to attest, countersign and affix the corporate seal to said duplicates of said contract. When said contract is so executed and when properly executed by the proper offices of the said Utah Power & Light Company the said Municipality is instructed to retain one of said duplicates as part of the records of his office and to deliver the other to said Utah Power & Light Company.

It was moved by Councilman Foote, seconded by Page, that authorization be granted to make application with Utah Power & Light Company for electric service at the new sanitary land fill for the operation of a well, that the foregoing resolution be adopted and that the Mayor and City Clerk be authorized to sign an electric service agreement in this regard. Roll call as follows: Ayes, 4; No, None; carried.

There being no further business, it was moved by Councilman Leahy, seconded by Page, that the Council adjourn. Carried.
