

JUNE 14, 1961

Pursuant to a call by the Mayor the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls met in Special Session in the Mayor's Chambers on June 14, 1961, at 10:30 A.M. for the purpose of considering the employment of a Director of Parks and Recreation, as well as any other business which might properly be presented. There were present at said Meeting: Mayor W. L. O'Bryant; Councilmen Leahy, Foote, Page. Absent, Councilman Creek. Also present: Roy C. Barnes, City Clerk; George Barnard, City Attorney.

After some discussion it was moved by Councilman Page, seconded by Foote, that Mr. Kelvin Nelson be employed by the City as Director of Parks and Recreation at an annual salary of \$8,400, effective July 15, 1961. Roll call as follows: Ayes, 3; No, None; carried.

It was noted that the Mead Addition Division #1 plat is virtually completed and that time is of the essence in this regard in anticipation of annexation. It was moved by Councilman Foote, seconded by Leahy, that the plat be approved and the Mayor and City Clerk be authorized to sign, subject to the approval of the Planning Commission and the City Engineer. Roll call as follows: Ayes, 3; No, None; carried.

ORDINANCE NO. 1002

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN LANDS TO THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS; DESCRIBING SAID LANDS AND DECLARING SAME A PART OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, IDAHO

The foregoing Ordinance was presented in title. It was moved by Councilman Leahy, seconded by Foote, that the provisions of Section 50-2004 of the Idaho Code requiring all ordinances to be fully and distinctly read on three several days be dispensed with. The question being "SHALL THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 50-2004 OF THE IDAHO CODE REQUIRING ALL ORDINANCES TO BE READ ON THREE SEVERAL DAYS BE DISPENSED WITH?" Roll call as follows: Ayes, 3; No, None; carried. The majority of all the members of the Council present having voted in the affirmative, the Mayor declared the rule dispensed with and ordered the Ordinance placed before the Council for final consideration, the question being, "SHALL THE ORDINANCE PASS?" subject to the approval of the aforementioned plat, subject to its being properly signed and recorded, and also subject to the approval of the Planning Commission and the Engineering Department. Roll call as follows: Ayes, 3; No, None; carried.

Finally, assuming the Mead Addition, Division #1 plat was properly approved, signed and recorded as described above and assuming the annexation ordinance was properly passed, the various subject provisions having been complied with, the City Clerk was given Council authorization to include this area in the notice of zoning hearing, to be held July 7th, 1961.

There being no further business, it was moved by Councilman Leahy, seconded by Page, that the Council adjourn. Carried.
