

MAY 15, 1961

Pursuant to a call by the Mayor the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls met in Special Session in the Mayor's Chambers on Monday, May 15, 1961 at 5:00 P.M. for the purpose of considering the awarding of a contract on the approaches to the John Adams Parkway Bridge, consider a curb, gutter and sidewalk contract for the coming year and any other business which might properly be presented. There were present at said Meeting: Mayor W. J. O'Bryant; Councilmen Foote, Page, Leahy, Creek. Also present: Roy C. Barnes, City Clerk; Don Lloyd, City Engineer.

Two informal proposals were reviewed for the construction of the approaches to the John Adams Parkway bridge as follows:

Allied Paving Company	\$4,987.50
Pickett & Nelson	4,350.00

It was moved by Councilman Leahy, seconded by Creek, that the contract be awarded to Pickett & Nelson. Roll call as follows: Ayes, 4; No, None; carried.

A discussion followed as to the need and advisability of obtaining the services of a reputable contractor to do all City curb, gutter and sidewalk construction during the coming fiscal year. It was moved by Councilman Leahy, seconded by Foote, that the City Engineer be authorized to prepare specifications and bids accordingly and that the contract limit construction and/or repair of this nature to approximately \$5,000.00. Roll call as follows: Ayes, 4; No, None; carried.

There being, no further business, it was moved by Councilman Leahy, seconded by Page, that the Council adjourn, carried.
