Pursuant to a call by the Mayor the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls met in Special Session in the Council Chambers on April 26, 1961 at 4:00 P.M. for the purpose of conducting the official canvas of ballots, cast at the second General Municipal Election held April 25, 1961, and any other items of business which might properly be presented. There were present at said Meeting: Mayor W. J. O'Bryant; Councilmen Johnson, Creek, Foote. Absent: Councilman Petersen. Also present: Roy C. Barnes, City Clerk; George Barnard, City Attorney; Harold Davis, Electrical Engineer.

The Mayor announced that this was the time and the place, as called by Special Session, for the official canvas of ballots on the second General Municipal Election, held April 25<sup>th</sup>, 1961. The City Clerk was instructed to open the ballot boxes and provide the Councilmen with the ballots and the tally sheet boxes. The following was revealed:

It was moved by Councilman Johnson, seconded by Creek, that the foregoing be declared as the official ballot count for the election as described. Roll call as follows: Ayes, 3; No, None; carried.

The City Attorney explained the new procedure covering trial by jury, if desired, in the City Police Court, effective May 2<sup>nd</sup>. It was pointed out that certain names must be provided from which a

jury panel can be selected. It was agreed that the City Clerk peruse the elector's registers and select the 100<sup>th</sup>, the 200<sup>th</sup>, the 300<sup>th</sup>, and 400<sup>th</sup> name from each precinct so that, from these, the City Attorney can be in a position to proceed.

The City Attorney noted that the Civil Service Manual should be re-edited to incorporate the recent changes as prescribed by law which takes effect May 2<sup>nd</sup>. It was moved by Councilman Creek, seconded by Johnson, that this be accomplished and a reasonable supply be printed. Roll call as follows: Ayes, 3; No, None; carried.

The City Clerk presented a utility bill in the name of the Idaho Falls Baseball Concession which was apparently billed contrary to a prior arrangement. It was moved by Councilman Creek, seconded by Johnson, that said bill in the amount of \$196.45 be charged off to clear the account. Roll call as follows: Ayes, 3; No, None; carried.

Electrical Engineer Davis advised that several Light Department employees not responsible for the handling of money, have, in the past, been bonded. It was moved by Councilman Johnson, seconded by Creek, that these bonds be discontinued. Roll call as follows: Ayes, 3; No, None; carried.

Davis then explained that a form has been devised similar to the one used by Civil Service, to be used for job applications. He said the form provided that the City Physician, under said form, is obliged to specify whether or not a particular job aspirant is physically suited for said job. The Council approved the form as recommended.

There being no further business, it was moved by Councilman Johnson, seconded by Petersen, that the Council adjourn; carried.
