

OCTOBER 28, 1960

The City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, County of Bonneville, State of Idaho, met in a Special Meeting on Friday, the 28th day of October, 1960, at the hour of 2:00 o'clock P.M., at the City Council Chambers in the City Hall at the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho; due and legal notice of said Meeting having been given as required by law and the rules and ordinances of the City. There were present at said Meeting: Mayor W. J. O'Bryant; Councilmen Donald R. Foote, Alex Creek, Vernon Johnson, George C. Petersen, Jr. Also present: Roy C. Barnes, City Clerk.

The City Clerk read the following proposed advertisement for bids in connection with the proposed sewer installation under Local Improvement District No. 26:

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed unit price proposals for the construction of the West Side Sewer System (Local Improvement District No. 26), addressed to the Mayor and City Council, City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, will be received at the office of the Mayor in the City Hall, Idaho Falls, Idaho, until 11:30 A.M. (MST) on the 21st day of November, 1960, and then will be publicly opened and read.

The work contemplated in this project consists of a system of lateral sewers which will provide sewer service to all properties located within Local Improvement District No. 26. This Local Improvement District is located within the City limits of Idaho Falls entirely on the west side of the Snake River. The major items of work in this contract include the furnishings and installing of approximately 24,450 lineal feet of 8-inch diameter sewer pipe, 8,300 lineal feet of 4-inch and 6-inch service pipe, and 94 concrete manholes, together with the necessary appurtenances. The City is permitting the use of concrete, clay, and asbestos cement pipe.

The work will be awarded to the one responsible bidder submitting the lowest acceptable bid.

Plans and specifications will be available at the office of the City Engineer, City Hall, Idaho Falls, Idaho, on November 7th. A copy of said documents may be obtained at the above office upon a deposit of \$10.00 for each set. The full amount of the deposit will be refunded if said documents are returned in good condition within fifteen (15) days after the date of the bid opening.

Each proposal must be submitted on the prescribed form and be accompanied by a certified check, cashier's check or bid bond payable to the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, in an amount not less than five percent (5%) of the amount bid.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish security for faithful performance of the contract in the full amount of the contract price.

The right is reserved to reject any and all proposals, to postpone the award of the contract for a period not to exceed thirty (30) days, and to accept that proposal which serves the best interest of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho.
