Pursuant to a call by the Mayor Pro-Tem the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls met in Special Session in the Mayor's Chambers on August 1, 1960 at 11:30 A.M. for the purpose of considering the adoption of a resolution which would authorize the City Treasurer of the City of Idaho Falls to transfer certain funds from the City Clerk's Electric Meter Deposit Fund to the General Fund, Airport Department Capital Outlay to be used for purchasing certain equipment for the lounge and the café at the airport. There were present at said Meeting: Mayor Pro Tem Vernon Johnson; Absent, Mayor W. J. O'Bryant. Present; Councilmen Foote, Petersen. Absent; Councilman Creek. Also present: Roy C. Barnes, City Clerk.

**RESOLUTION (Resolution No. 1960-08)**

WHEREAS, the City of Idaho Falls has heretofore leased from Restaurant and Store Equipment Company et al certain equipment for the café and bar in the new administration building at the Idaho Falls Municipal Airport, with option to buy the same, and,

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined it would be for the best interests of the City to exercise its option to purchase said equipment at the present time and thereby save to the City the rental and carrying charges accruing under the lease of said equipment, and,

WHEREAS, the City has available an unexpended balance in the Clerk's Electric Meter Deposit Fund which will not be required for meter deposit refunds during the current fiscal year:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Treasurer of the City of Idaho Falls be, and she hereby is, authorized and directed to transfer \$18,613.88 from said Meter Deposit Fund to the General Fund, Airport Department Capitol Outlay, to be used for the purpose of purchasing said equipment.

Provided, however, that the amount so transferred shall be retransferred to said Clerk's Electric Meter Deposit Fund from any unexpected balance in the General Fund, Airport Department, prior to the end of the current fiscal year.
