

JULY 22, 1960

The City Council of the City of Idaho Falls reconvened in the Mayor's Chambers at 10:00 A.M. in a meeting which was recessed to this time and date, continued from the previous night, July 21st, 1960.

The Clifford Kirkendall request, presented the evening of July 21st, 1960 by Mr. Arthur Smith, local attorney, was again reviewed. It was moved by Councilman Petersen, seconded by Johnson, that the request be denied on the grounds that erection of a building to be occupied by the I.D. Department Store at a location adjoining the Bowl-Ero Bowling Alley could not be permitted due to lack of sufficient parking as prescribed by ordinance. Roll call as follows: Ayes, Councilmen Petersen, Johnson, Foote; No, None; Councilman Creek abstained from voting, carried.

There being no further business, it was moved by Councilman Johnson, seconded by Petersen, that the Council adjourn, carried.
