

JUNE 30, 1960

Pursuant to a call by the Mayor the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls met in Special Session in the Mayor's Chambers on June 30, 1960 at 3:00 p.m. for the purpose of considering for approval a grant offer from the Federal Aviation Agency for Government participation of City expenditure in clear zone property, fencing, etc. at the Municipal Airport, as well as any other business which might properly be presented. There were present at said Meeting: Mayor W. J. O'Bryant; Councilmen Foote, Petersen, Johnson. Absent: Councilman Creek. Also present: Roy C. Barnes, City Clerk; George Barnard, City Attorney.

A grant offer was presented from the Federal Aviation Agency which would provide Federal Aid, as directed and provided in the instrument, to the City of clear zone property previously acquired at the Municipal Airport. In this regard, the following resolution was introduced by Councilman Foote, seconded by Councilman Johnson, read in full and considered, and unanimously adopted:

RESOLUTION (Resolution No. 1960-06)

RESOLUTION ACCEPTING, ADOPTING APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION ON A GRANT AGREEMENT RECEIVED FROM THE ADMINISTRATOR, FEDERAL AVIATION AGENCY, UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, BEING PROJECT NO. 9-10-060-6009, AND CONTRACT NO. FA4-996, FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF FANNING FIELD, IDAHO FALLS, IDAHO.

Be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho.

Section 1: That the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, by and through its City Council, shall enter into a Grant Agreement for the purpose of obtaining Federal Aid in the development of Fanning Field and that such agreement shall be as set forth below.

Section 2. That the Mayor be, and he is hereby authorized and directed, to execute said Grant Agreement in quintuplet on behalf of the City of Idaho Falls, and the City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to impress the Official Seal of the City of Idaho Falls, thereon and to attest said execution.

Section 3. That all statements, representations, warrants, covenants, and agreements contained in the Project Application for Federal Aid in the development of Fanning Field are hereby specifically ratified and adopted.

Section 4. That the Grant Agreement referred to hereinabove shall be as follows:

Fencing at the Airport was discussed. It was moved by Councilman Johnson, seconded by Foote, that the City Attorney be instructed to prepare an Ordinance repealing Section 7219 of the Revised Code of Idaho Falls, 1950 edition which prohibits certain types of fencing being used within the City limits. Roll call as follows: Ayes, 3; No, None; carried.

A letter was read from Mr. Ted Pike of the Attorney firm of Albaugh, Bloem, and Smith pertaining to the Darrell Anderson claim in the amount of \$240.00 for services rendered in the cleaning of a ditch at the Cemetery. It was noted that the City feels that only one half of that amount

is justified and that the Hatch Clinic would be obligated for one half of that amount, of \$60.00. It was moved by Councilman Petersen, seconded by Johnson, that the City Attorney be authorized to reply to said letter, denying the sum of \$230.00 and allowing the claim in the amount of \$120.00. Roll call as follows: Ayes, 3; No, None; Carried.

Councilman Petersen commented on the immediate need for a vacuum cleaner for use at the Municipal Swimming Pool. He advised against resorting to specifications in this instance as time is of the essence, so that it could be of use during this current swimming season. The Mayor authorized him to work through the Purchasing Agent, clearing first with the Controller, to acquire this item.

There being no further business, it was moved by Councilman Johnson, seconded by Petersen, that the Council adjourn; carried.
