Pursuant to a call by the Mayor the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls met in Special Session in the Mayor's Chambers on June 22, 1960 at 3:00 P.M. for the purpose of selecting a successful bidder and awarding the contract on the fencing job at the Airport. There were present at said Meeting: Mayor W. J. O'Bryant; Councilmen Johnson, Foote, Petersen. Absent: Councilman Creek. Also present: Roy C. Barnes, City Clerk; Don Lloyd, City Engineer.

The City Engineer reported that the low bidder on the fencing job at the Airport was the D. M. Anderson Company. However, the City Council found it necessary to disqualify the bid in view of the fact that Mr. Anderson, although application has apparently been made, was not a licensed contractor which is a pre-requisite to bidding on municipal work of this nature. Consequently, it was then moved by Councilman Johnson, seconded by Foote, that it be recommended to the Federal Aviation Agency that the second low bidder, Rickett & Nelson, be awarded the fencing contract in the amount of \$9,053.95. Roll call as follows: Ayes, 3; No, None; carried.

There being no further business, it was moved by Councilman Johnson, seconded by Petersen, that the Council adjourn; carried.
