

JUNE 14, 1960

Pursuant to a call by the Mayor the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls met in Special Session in the Bonneville Hotel on June 14th, 1960, at 12:00 Noon for the purpose of considering the approval of a side sewer connection for certain property located at 1014 Blaine Avenue. There were present at said Meeting: Mayor W. J. O'Bryant; Councilmen Petersen, Johnson, Foote. Absent: Councilman Alex Creek. Also present: Roy C. Barnes, City Clerk; Donald F. Lloyd, City Engineer.

The City Engineer presented a matter for Council approval; namely, authorization for a side sewer connection at the Mrs. Vernon Jeppesen property at 1014 Blaine Avenue. It was moved by Councilman Johnson, seconded by Foote, that this be permitted, providing Mrs. Jeppesen stand the expense of the necessary right of way. It was understood that she will stand the expense of removing any rock encountered during trench excavation and that she will sign a promissory note for the cost of the trenching. Roll call as follows: Ayes, 3; No, None; carried.

There being no further business, it was moved by Councilman Johnson, seconded by Petersen, that the Council adjourn; carried.
