

MARCH 14, 1960

Pursuant to a call by the Mayor the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls met in Special Session in the Mayor's Chambers on March 14, 1960 at 11:00 A.M. for the purpose of opening sealed bids on crushing gravel.

There were present at said Meeting: Mayor W. J. O'Bryant; Councilmen Petersen, Johnson, Creek, Foote. Also present: Roy C. Barnes, City Clerk; George Barnard, City Attorney; Don Lloyd, City Engineer.

The Mayor announced that this was the time and the place for the opening of sealed bids for the crushing of gravel for City use in a minimum amount of 20,000 cubic yards and instructed the City Clerk to proceed. The following were revealed.

Carl E. Nelson, Logan, Utah	1.00 per cubic yard
Western Construction, Pocatello, Idaho	1.20 per cubic yard
Pickett & Nelson, Idaho Falls, Idaho	.95 per cubic yard

It was moved by Councilman Foote, seconded by Johnson, that the low bid of Barnhart & Wheeler be accepted. Roll call as follows: Ayes, 4; No, None; carried.

There being no further business, it was moved by Councilman Johnson, seconded by Petersen, that the Council adjourn, carried.
