

JANUARY 25, 1960

Pursuant to a call by the Mayor the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls met in Special Session in the Mayor's Chambers on January 25, 1960 at 3:00 P.M. for the purpose of awarding the successful bid on the pump for the No. 3 well, considering a special request for the construction of a sign and other business which might properly be presented. There were present at said Meeting: Mayor W. J. O'Bryant; Councilmen Foote, Petersen, Johnson, Creek. Also present: Roy C. Barnes, City Clerk; Don Lloyd, City Engineer; Alva Harris, Building Official.

The pump bids opened January 18, 1960, were reviewed. It was explained by the City Engineer that, even though the Johnston bid was slightly higher than the lowest, it provided for the better efficiency of the two. It was moved by Councilman Johnson, seconded by Petersen, that the Johnston Pump Company be named as the successful bidder. Roll call as follows: Ayes, 4; No, None; carried.

A request from Mr. Wally Sayer was made to install a directional sign on City property on the west end of the Broadway Bridge. It had been explained that the sign, even though it was primarily for the purpose of directing traffic to his motel, also made reference to a scenic drive. The Council approved installation of the sign.

There being no further business, it was moved by Councilman Johnson, seconded by Petersen, that the Council adjourn, carried.
