

JANUARY 19, 1960

Pursuant to a call by the Mayor the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls met in Special Session in the Mayor's Chambers on January 19, 1960 at 3:00 P.M. for the purpose of considering the approval of an agreement with Mercury International Sales & Service Company and also an amendment covering six FAA contracts and creating a provision for automatic renewal for a number of years. There were present at said Meeting: Mayor W. J. O'Bryant: Councilmen Petersen, Johnson, Creek, Foote. Also present: Roy C. Barnes, City Clerk; George Barnard, City Attorney.

An agreement was presented between the City of Idaho Falls and Mercury International Sales & Service Company which would permit that Company, over the counter and through vending machines, to provide travel insurance service at the Municipal Airport. It was moved by Councilman Creek, seconded by Petersen, that the Mayor be authorized to sign the agreement. Roll call as follows: Ayes, 4; No, None; carried.

Next to be presented were six amendments to FAA contracts providing for automatic renewal for a number of years as follows:
