

JANUARY 18, 1960

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Pursuant to a call by the Mayor the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls met in Special Session in the Mayor's Chambers on January 18, 1960, at 10:30 A.M. for the purpose of opening sealed bids on a bowl assembly and part of a shaft for the No. 3 well. There were present at said Meeting: Mayor W. J. O'Bryant; Councilmen Foote, Petersen, Johnson. Absent: Councilman Creek. Also present: Roy C. Barnes, City Clerk; Don Lloyd, City Engineer.

The Mayor announced that this was the time and the place for the opening of sealed bids on a bowl assembly and part of a shaft for the No. 3 well and instructed the City Clerk to proceed. The following bids were revealed.

| Snake River Equipment, Idaho Falls, Idaho  | 3,173.60   |
| Fairbanks More & Co., Salt Lake City, Utah<br>(Bid phoned to the City Engineer with assurance<br>that it would be verified in writing) | 2,950.00   |

It was then explained that the low bid would not necessarily prove itself the successful one, as there are many matters of efficiency to consider. The bids were referred to the City Engineer for study and recommendation and it was tentatively decided that the successful bidder would be announced Wednesday evening, January 20<sup>th</sup>, 1960.

There being no further business, it was moved by Councilman Johnson, seconded by Petersen, that the Council adjourn; carried.
