Pursuant to a call by the Mayor the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls met in Special Session in the Mayor's Chambers on December 1, 1959 at 2:00 P.M. for the purpose of considering the approval of certain City licenses, and any other business which might properly be presented. There were present at said Meeting: Mayor W. J. O'Bryant; Councilmen Johnson, Creek, Foote, Petersen. Also present: Roy C. Barnes, City Clerk; George Barnard, City Attorney.

License applications were presented for SOFT DRINKS: Fords, 444 A Street; Broadway Bowl, 453 Broadway; White Horse Bar, 545 Shoup Ave.; Matson's Service, 298 So. Yellowstone; Happy Jacks, 251 Broadway; Russett Bar, 309 Broadway; Corner Grocery, 575 N. Ridge; Jack's Chicken Inn, 1950 S. Yellowstone. BOWLING ALLEY B.P.O.E. #1087. It was moved by Councilman Creek, seconded by Johnson, that the licenses be approved. Roll call as follows: Ayes, 4; No, None; carried.

Applications for MEAT MARKET were presented as follows: Matson's Service, 298 S. Yellowstone; Corner Grocery, 575 N. Ridge. It was moved by Councilman Foote, seconded by Johnson, that the licenses be granted subject to the approval of the City Sanitarian. Roll call as follows: Ayes, 4; No, None; carried.

License application was presented for an ELECTRICAL CONTRACTOR as follows: Pocatello Electric Supply Company by Edgar E. Hill. It was moved by Councilman Foote, seconded by Johnson, that the license be granted, subject to the approval of the Electrical Inspector. Roll call as follows: Ayes, 4; No, None; carried.

An easement was presented between Stanger Farms, Inc. and the City of Idaho Falls covering a right of way for a power line on the north side of Anderson Street between the Lewisville Highway and the Yellowstone Highway on the south boundary of the Stanger property. It was moved by Councilman Petersen, seconded by Creek, that the Mayor be authorized to sign. Roll call as follows: Ayes, 4; No, None; carried.

A summons was presented to the City of Idaho Falls covering the Faber Tway claim in the amount of \$61.00, originally presented August 21<sup>st</sup>, 1959. It was agreed that this should be referred to the City Insurance Carrier.

There being no further business, it was moved by Councilman Johnson, seconded by Creek, that the Council adjourn, carried.
