

NOVEMBER 2, 1959

Pursuant to a call by the Mayor the City Council met in special session in the Mayor's Chambers on November 2, 1959 at 11:30 A.M. for the purpose of considering the approval of a contract between Bonneville County and the City of Idaho Falls, parties of the first part and the Idaho State Board of Health, party of the second part; also, any other business which might properly be presented. There were present at said meeting Mayor W. J. O'Bryant, Councilmen Creek, Foote, Petersen, Johnson. Also present Roy C. Barnes, City Clerk, George Barnard, City Attorney.

Dr. John Casper, County Health Doctor, appeared before the Council with a contract ready for signature between the Bonneville County Board of Commissioners and the City of Idaho Falls, parties of the first part and the Idaho State Board of Health, party of the second part, terms of which are from January 11, 1960 to January 9, 1961, defining a public health program and the manner in which it is to be administered and providing for joint county, city and state financing. It was moved by Councilman Johnson, seconded by Creek, that the Mayor and City Clerk be authorized to sign. Roll call as follows: Ayes, 4; No, none; carried.

The Mayor then read minutes of a meeting of the Traffic Safety Committee, held October 29th, 1959 and it was agreed that said minutes, whether to be eventually approved and acted upon by the Council or not, might well be released to the press to indicate that said Committee is constructively functioning.

Bids on the police car, originally presented October 16th, 1959 involving a trade in for a 1955 Chevrolet, were again discussed. In view of the City's extremely tight financial predicament the Council felt that a further study should be made to determine the need for a new car at this time. The Mayor volunteered to investigate further on this matter and report back to the Council.

There being no further business, it was moved by Councilman Johnson, seconded by Petersen that the Council adjourn; carried.
