

JUNE 3, 1959

Pursuant to a call by the Mayor the City Council met in Special Session in the Mayors Chambers on June 3, 1959 at 11:00 A.M. for the purpose of considering the acceptance of an auditing contract between the City of Idaho Falls and the accounting firm of Burnett and Humphreys. There were present at said Meeting: Mayor W. J. O'Bryant; Councilmen Johnson, Creek, Foote. Absent: Councilman Petersen. Also present: Roy C. Barnes, City Clerk; R. Vern Kidwell, City Attorney; Sterling Mason of the Accounting firm of Burnett and Humphreys.

Mr. Mason presented a contract for Council approval between the City of Idaho Falls and the accounting firm of Burnett and Humphreys covering auditing services to April 30, 1960. It was moved by Councilman Johnson, seconded by Creek, that the contract be approved and the Mayor and City Clerk be authorized to sign. Roll call as follows: Ayes, 3; No, None; carried.

The Mayor brought the Councilmen's attention to the Rodeo Grounds Maintenance Fund on which authorized signatures for drawing checks still calls for John B. Rogers and a legion member.

There being no further business, it was moved by Councilman Johnson, seconded by Foote, that the Council adjourn; carried.
