RECESSED MEETING

---

The City Council of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho met in the Mayor's Chambers at 2:00 P.M. for a continuation of the August 7<sup>th</sup> Meeting, recessed until this time. There were present at said Meeting: Mayor John B. Rogers; Councilmen Foote, Petersen, Johnson; Absent, Councilman Freeman. Also present: Roy C. Barnes, City Clerk; Arthur L. Smith, City Attorney.

There was continued discussion on the William Hatch property matter. The Council was reminded that Mr. Hatch owes the City \$3,000.00 on a water line; also, that he had at one time indicated interest in two City lots in the area in question that had previously been acquired from him for \$7,000.00. It was agreed to offer Mr. Hatch the following for his property; Cancellation of the \$3,000.00 water line obligation; the two City lots, placing a value on same at \$7,000.00 and \$35,000.00 on a five year contract. It was understood that if this offer was not acceptable, any further negotiations would be handled, in Mr. Hatch's absence, through his attorneys.

There being no further business, it was moved by Councilman Johnson, seconded by Petersen, that the Council adjourn. Carried.
