Pursuant to a call by the Mayor the City Council of the City of Idaho Falls met in Special Session August 4, 1958, at 11:00 A.M. in the Council Chambers for the purpose of signing the contract with Arrington Construction Company for the building of the new Airport Administration Building. Dear Mr. Rogers:

A representative from this office was present at a meeting held in the Council Chambers of the City Building of Idaho Falls, Idaho on July 25, 1958, at which time bids were opened for subject project. It is noted that you have recommended that the contract be awarded to Arrington Construction Company, Inc., Idaho Falls, Idaho, the low bidder, in the amount of \$441,000.00.

Your recommendations are concurred in and you are hereby given clearance to make the award of contract as far as the Civil Aeronautics Administration is concerned. The contract should be executed at your earliest convenience.

It is requested that this office be furnished two conformed copies of the executed contract and one conformed copy of the performance bond. Copies of the contract and performance bond that are submitted to this office do not need to be executed; typed names and dates on these documents will be sufficient.

When the grant offer has been executed and checked for legality and copies of the contract and performance bond have received in this office, we shall be in a position to issue the Notice to Proceed.
