

SPECIAL MEETING

MAY 8, 1958

Pursuant to a call by the Mayor, the City Council met in Special Session in the Council Chambers on May 8, 1958, at 8:00 P.M. for the purpose of holding a zoning hearing on the site of the new Elks Lodge. There were present at said Meeting: Mayor John B. Rogers; Councilmen Petersen, Freeman, Johnson. Absent: Councilman Foote. Also present: Roy C. Barnes, City Clerk.

The Mayor announced that this was the time and place for hearing all protests, both written and verbal to the following described land:

Lots Seven (7) to Eighteen (18), both inclusive, and Lots Thirty-one (31) to Forty-two (42), both inclusive, in Block One (1), Capitol Hill Addition to the City of Idaho Falls, per the recorded plat thereof.

Commonly referred as the future building site of the Elks Lodge.

There being no protests, it was understood that the Council was now free to rezone the property to fit the needs of the contemplated lodge.

There being no further business, it was moved by Councilman Johnson, seconded by Petersen, that the Council adjourn. Carried.
