

APRIL 9, 1958

Pursuant to a call by the Mayor, the City Council met in Special Session in the Council Chambers on April 9, 1958 for the purpose of arriving at a hook-on-charge for new sewer connections. There were present at said Meeting: Mayor John B. Rogers; Councilmen Johnson, Petersen, Freeman, Foote. Also present: Roy C. Barnes, City Clerk; Arthur Smith, City Attorney.

After considerable discussion it was moved by Councilman Johnson, seconded by Petersen, that the hook-on-charge be set at \$100.00, effective on the date of publication of the Ordinance; also, that effective January 1, 1959, the charge is to be raised to \$118.00. Roll call as follows: Ayes, 4; No, None; carried.

The Mayor requested of the Councilmen, and was granted the authority to cancel the contract now existing between the City of Idaho Falls and Utah Power and Light for furnishing electricity to the City, said cancellation to be effective June 30, 1958.

The Council agreed to give the tenants of Vet's Housing, 30 days notice to vacate, effective June 1, 1958, after which it was agreed that the units should be sold.

There being no further business, it was moved by Councilman Johnson, seconded by Petersen, that the Council adjourn. Carried.
